Award Qualification

- Chapters must update marketing assets (websites, social media, etc) with new WIFS branding OR local branding complementary to the new WIFS branding by **May 1**.
- Applications must include point documentation and be submitted on or before August 15th each year.
- Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Chapter that scores the highest number of qualifying points receives the award.
- All information is subject to verification.





Qualifying Points - 250 Total

(20) Chapter officer participation in all monthly Chapter Leader meetings
(10) Chapter detail form submitted in final form by November 30th
(10) Annual report and financial statement submitted in final form by December 31st
(10) Business Plan received by January 31
(10) Have 3+ designated Chapter Directors (Marketing, Membership, Sponsorship etc)
Attract Activities (Membership Growth) - 75 points
(10) Establish a Chapter theme for 2023 and share with National by May 1
(10) Chapter engages members on social media — must tag National in 10 posts
(15) Added 5 new (chapter dues paying) members from January 1–July 31
(10) Added 2 new student members from January 1–July 31

Develop Activities (Content/Career Development) – 45 points
